## **Part 2: Student/Parent Agreement**

Additional requirements/guidelines:

- All leadership students must be passing all classes with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA. Even if you are accepted into leadership, if your GPA falls below a 2.5, or you receive a failing grade in any class at the end of the 2018/2019 school year, you will no longer be enrolled in leadership for 2018/2019. Additionally, if you receive a failing grade at the end of first semester you will be asked to switch to an alternate elective.
- Students will also undergo an eligibility check (including attendance and behavior) for the past 2 school years. Any issues may result in ineligibility for leadership.
- Participation in all assigned/required school wide events. Students are also reminded that Leadership requires a **significant time** outside of class including summer, evenings and weekends. Attendance at events is mandatory unless prearranged and excused (work is not an excused absence). Excessive absences at events will lower class grade and could result in placement in an alternate elective at semester.
- All leadership students are required to see the drug and alcohol presentation and undergo co-curricular clearance each school year. 100% compliance with Drug and Alcohol Policy is expected.
- All leadership students must attend the random drug testing presentation as part of the requirement for co-curricular clearance.
- Leadership students are required to complete 20 hours of volunteer/community service per semester. Students are also required to attend DHS PTSO meetings and DC School Board meetings.
- Students who are accepted into leadership will be required to sign both a class contract and a code of conduct.
- In addition to the teacher and personal recommendations, other DHS staff members may be consulted to consider your abilities to be a member of student leadership. All recommendations are confidential.
