### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Douglas High School is a public four-year high school with 1,694 students in Minden, Nevada. The campus is located in a rural valley in Douglas County and is the larger of two high schools in the district. Douglas County has a population of 52,000 residents. Primary local industries are construction, gaming, ranching and small manufacturing. The town is located 15 miles south of Carson City and 45 miles south of Reno.

The grading system is computed on a four-point scale. Bonus points are awarded for Honors and AP courses.

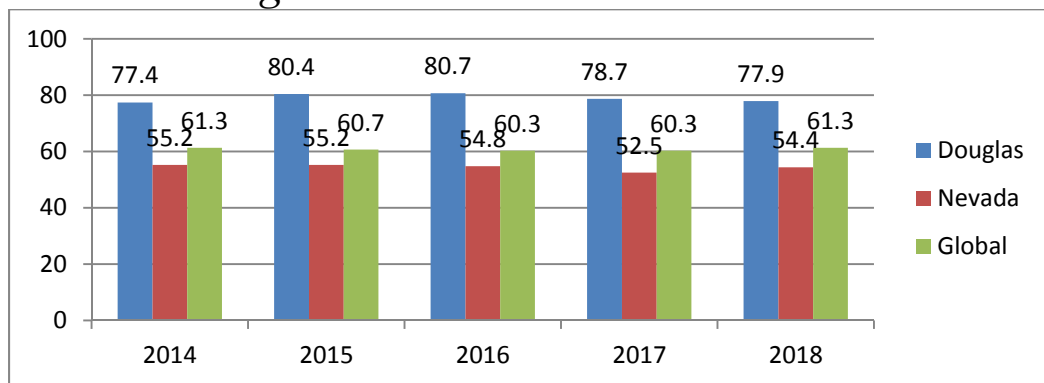
