Parents of Graduating Seniors,

We are just a few weeks away from graduation! All the members of the Douglas High community wish to extend heartfelt congratulations to you and your student for all of the hard work and dedication to reach this milestone! With graduation approaching so quickly, we want to make you aware of these last minute items to ensure a smooth graduation process for you and your student.

Graduating seniors are expected to dress and act appropriately before and during the graduation ceremony to respect the process and uphold the dignity this day deserves. Student dress should be business casual: an appropriate dress, skirt and blouse, or slacks and blouse, and appropriate dress shoes for girls; collared shirts and appropriate pants and shoes for boys. Torn/ripped clothing, T-shirts, shorts, blue jeans, tennis shoes, and flip flops are not appropriate. In addition, only school-issued cords, stoles, and medals are allowed to be worn with the graduation gowns. Students who are not dressed appropriately will be given an opportunity to self-correct their attire. Failure to self-correct will result in being dismissed from the graduation ceremony.

Please be aware, the use of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products is strictly prohibited at all times. Students who are in possession of or observed using alcohol, drugs of any kind, tobacco, or vaping devices at any point prior to or during the graduation ceremony will be immediately dismissed from the ceremony.

Finally, please note the ceremony site will open at 3:30 p.m. on June 6th for you to come and take your seats. Please plan on being in your seats by 5:00 p.m. to allow for the entrance of the graduates. Handicapped seating will also open up at 3:30 p.m. If you need to reserve handicapped seating for the ceremony, please contact our head secretary Karan Seelbinder at 782-5136 X1711 and she will reserve a seat for your family member.
