Information:

- Two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$1500 dollars each will be awarded to a graduating student at Douglas High School. This is available to a student who intends to pursue a career in a Medically Related field.
- The student must be graduating at the end of the 2018-2019 school year with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Mid-year graduates are also eligible.
- Scholarships are valid for the 2019-2020 school year unless previous arrangements have been made.
- The award will be based on:
 1. **Academic achievement**
 2. **Personal autobiography**
 3. **Financial need**
 4. **Two (2) letters of recommendation from supported teachers, employers, or an outside source.**

Instructions:

- Two letters of recommendation **MUST** accompany the application.
- An official transcript of grades earned at DHS must accompany all applications.
- A resume listing extracurricular and/or community activities, employment or other activities in order of importance to you. Indicate the dates you participated in these activities, positions held, and the number of hours per week spent on each activity. We realize that the ways spent outside the classroom may be affected by factors beyond control, such as the need to work. Include any significant awards, honors that were received during high school or community college for academic or extracurricular achievements.
- An autobiography, including the applicant's personal interests in a medically related profession **MUST** accompany the application.

Complete Application packages must be received at Barton Memorial Hospital Front Desk on or before 5:00 PM on March 15, 2019. Applications may also be mailed in order for them to be received or delivered no later than March 15, 2019 to Barton Memorial Hospital Auxiliary, 2170 South Avenue, South Lake Tahoe, CA 96150 to the attention of the Scholarship Chair.
