VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP Scholarship Criteria

Each year, graduating students from Douglas County area high schools may be selected to receive the **CARSON VALLEY SERTOMA CLUB VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP** for books, materials, and/or fees. This scholarship will be paid in renewable increments up to the amount of the scholarship.

Scholarship money is paid only for the cost of books, materials, and fees relating to that recipient's curriculum and will be paid each semester while student is enrolled in a school of his/her choice. Proof of registration is required. Maintenance of passing grades and continued pursuit in the chosen discipline is required.

Following the purchase, the student will submit the receipts and a copy of the registration form indicating the classes taken, and the fees and material costs, and a copy of a progress report or grades.

When these documents are received, the Scholarship Program Chairman will request payment from the Carson Valley Sertoma treasurer. The reimbursement check will be mailed to the student.

Criteria for Selection

- The student must be enrolled in a program of a vocational training curriculum (auto tech, nursing, medical tech, culinary, skilled craftsmen, truck driver, welder, cosmetology, etc.).
- In high school, the student must have maintained passing grades.
- The student must show at least one activity demonstrating betterment of the high school and/or community.
- The student should present at least **TWO** letters of recommendation in support of his/her potential success in post-high school education.
- Complete this scholarship application form with all the information requested before the deadline.
- Finalists must be willing to be interviewed for the Carson Valley Sertoma Club Vocational Scholarship.
- **If awarded the scholarship, the student must be willing to attend the Carson Valley Sertoma Scholarship Breakfast in May.**
