SCHOLARSHIP

ATTEND WNC FREE IN 2018!

Nevada Promise is a scholarship and mentoring program which makes free college possible for students in our state, under 20 years of age.

SCHOLARSHIP

Nevada Promise covers class fees not covered by the Pell grant, the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship or the Silver State Opportunity Grant.

WNC is now accepting applications. Students must apply for the scholarship by October 31, 2017. Funding for Nevada Promise will be issued from the state on a first come, first serve basis.

MENTORSHIP

WNC will assign mentors to assist students with Nevada Promise scholarship requirements, as well as the WNC admissions and financial aid processes.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Nevada Promise requires students to complete 20 hours of community service, by April 30, 2018.

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

- Must be younger than 20 years old and not previously have been awarded an associate or bachelor's degree.
- Must be a bona fide resident of the state.
- Must have a high school diploma awarded by a public or private high school from Nevada or a public high school located in a county that borders this state that accepts pupils who are residents of this state, or a general equivalency diploma or equivalent document.
- Must not be in default of any federal student loan and not owe a refund to any federal program providing aid to students.
- Submit the WNC Nevada Promise application by Oct. 31, 2017.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2018-19 by March 30, 2018.
(FAFSA for 2018-19 goes live on October 1, 2017.)
- Perform 20 hours of community service by April 30, 2018.
- Complete additional requirements for orientations, mentorship, class load and college GPA, of which WNC will guide applicants.
