**2019**

A scholarship may only be granted to a **Female** student of **Nordic heritage** registered in a full-time program at an accredited high school in their senior year on schedule for a diploma or enrolled in an institution of higher education, i.e. college, university, technical school or vocational school. The student shall be verifiably enrolled in classes with a good standing and have a grade point average of 2.7 or better. The Scholarship Committee shall determine other pertinent criteria in its selection of prospective recipients. "An applicant may apply for a Queen Maud Lodge #42 Memorial Scholarship as often as desired, but a recipient of an award may not re-apply."

Complete the Application Form dated **2019**

1. Please include information on your Nordic heritage through one or both parents, not to go further back than great-grandparents.. Shall be of Danish, Finnish, Icelandic, Norwegian or Swedish decent or of any combination thereof in whole or in part.
2. On a separate sheet of paper, please write a brief personal history, including your relationship to your Nordic heritage. Include your educational and career goals. (one page – no more than 400 words). Please keep in mind that it is just as important to write about personal experiences and goals, as it is to include facts about participation in organizations and activities. Write the biography in a narrative that is easy to read.
3. Obtain the most recent transcript from your high school, college or university, technical, or vocational school.
4. Submit a letter of recommendation (one page, no more than 400 words), on school letterhead, in a sealed envelope with the same letterhead from a member of the faculty of the school you attend.
5. Submit a personal recommendation from someone other than a relative (one page, no more than 400 words), in a sealed envelope addressed to Scholarship Committee. Contact the people who will write the recommendations as soon as possible, as it takes time to write recommendations. It is your responsibility to follow up and make sure the recommendations will reach you in time to mail postmarked by the March 15th, 2019 deadline.

To qualify for consideration: Do not omit or make any substitutions to the above requirements. Mail all items in one large manila envelope (postmarked by March 15, 2019) to: Scholarship Committee
