SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Douglas High School is a public three-year high school with 1,259 students in Minden, Nevada. The campus is located in a rural valley in Douglas County and is the larger of two high schools in the district. Douglas County has a population of 52,000 residents. Primary local industries are construction, gaming, ranching and small manufacturing. The town is located 15 miles south of Carson City and 45 miles south of Reno.

The grading system is computed on a four-point scale, with a five-point scale for Honors and AP classes.

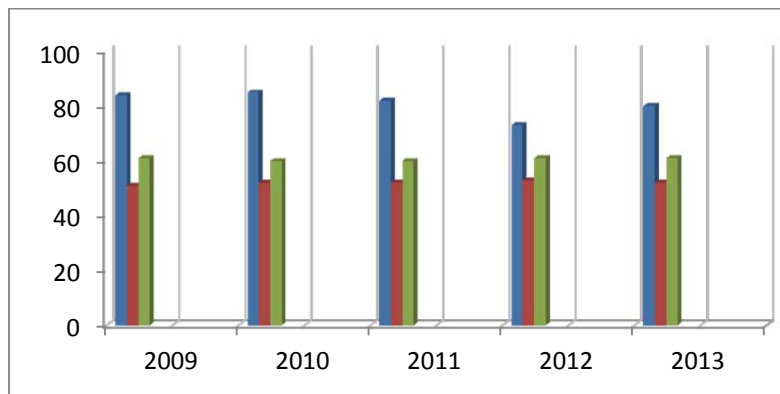

Highlights*

- Our fine arts students earned over 84 scholastic key awards this year.
- Our Army JROTC program continues as an Honor Unit with Distinction, the highest ranking of the JROTC programs can receive
- Our Future Farmers of America chapter's dairy judging team earned bronze, and the veterinary science team placed 6th out of 79 teams at nationals.
- In spring of 2012, our girls' swimming and diving team was league and regional champions, finishing 4th in the state.
- In fall of 2012, our boys' cross country team was league regional runner-up.
- Our boys' basketball received the Division 1 Academic Excellence Award.
- In 2012, 244 students participated in AP course work and took 385 examinations with 73% receiving a score of 3 or better.
